Field materials

Taped interviews with 19 informants, 1–3 hours per person, and transcripts of these. In addition, a shorter interview documented by notes in a field diary. Several informants have agreed to the interviews being archived at the Folklife Archives in Lund, serial number M27092–M27102. A telephone interview of 19 September 2013 with the present Press Ombudsman, Ola Sigvardsson, is also part of the material. In addition, telephone conversations in May 2015 with the Chair of the Ängsbacken sports club (fictitious name), email correspondence, and telephone lists are part of the material for Chapter 3.
